During the nineteenth century many of
Europe's capital cities were subject to
major expansion and improvement
schemes. From Vienna's Ringstrasse to
the boulevards of Paris, the townscapes
which emerged still shape today's cities
and are an inalienable part of European
cultural heritage. In Planning Europe's
Capital Cities, Thomas Hall examines the
planning process in fifteen of those cities
and addresses the following questions:
when and why did planning begin, and

celebrazioni dei centenari di Carlo V e Filippo II hanno contribuito a porre al centro di vivaci riflessioni storiografiche.
