Das 21. Jahrhundert ist durch zunehmenden direkten und medialen Austausch zwischen Menschen verschiedener Kulturkreise geprägt und wird daher häufig als „Zeitalter der Globalisierung“ bezeichnet. Parallel zur Globalisierung ist „Lokalisierung“ beobachtbar, es werden also lokale Erscheinungen verstärkt. Dieses gleichzeitige und in Wechselwirkung stehende Auftreten von Globalisierung und Lokalisierung wird unter dem Begriff „Glokalisierung“ gefasst. Karoline Heyder analysiert, inwieweit sich Glokalisierung aktuell im Bereich der französischen Sprache beobachten

lässt. Des Weiteren erläutert Heyder, welche Implikationen sich hieraus für die Didaktik des Sprach- und speziell des Französischunterrichts ableiten lassen. Empirisch untersucht werden das Sprachverhalten, das Sprachbewusstsein, die Spracheinstellungen und die Sprecheridentität jugendlicher Suisses romands sowie der Umgang mit dem Regionalfranzösischen in der westschweizerischen Schule. Hierauf sowie auf einer Analyse einschlägiger Bildungsvorgaben basierend zeigt die Autorin, welche Anknüpfungspunkte sich für die bildungspolitisch auf schweizerischer Ebene angestrebte Förderung der Mehrsprachigkeit aus sprachdidaktischer Sicht bieten. Dabei wird verdeutlicht, wie unter Berücksichtigung der ermittelten empirischen Ergebnisse, bestehender didaktisch-methodischer Ansätze zur Förderung von Mehrsprachigkeit sowie einschlägiger Bildungsvorgaben die varietale Mehrsprachigkeitskompetenz jugendlicher Suisses romands gefördert und somit nicht zuletzt zum reflektierten Umgang mit Sprache in Zeiten der Glokalisierung beigetragen werden kann.

This book is the first and only comprehensive biography of the life of General-leutnant Fritz Bayerlein (1899-1970), Erwin Rommels former Chief-of-Staff and commander of the elite Panzer Lehr Division during World War II. Bayerlein is often quoted and equally criticized for his military failures and successes. His experiences with General Heinz Guderian in the invasion of Poland, France and Russia, along with North Africa, Hungary, Normandy and the Ruhr cover six years of intense war. During the Russian winter of 1943-1944, Bayerlein commanded the famous Berlin-Brandenburg 3rd Panzer Division. Officers and soldiers describe his battle experiences and provide valuable insight into the character and personality of this highly unusual panzer general. In addition, Spayd has edited many of the military manuscripts, articles and correspondence Bayerlein wrote which serve as the backbone of many of the chapters. In the process Bayerlein tells his own story and shows his feelings and frustrations on fighting a war of useless bloodshed. Using Bayerleins experiences, blended with personal accounts, the biography is a discovery of the range of his temperament from raging anger over decisions made by superiors, to the gentleness of giving chocolate to children. The author researched Bayerleins life for over five years, discovering documents and photographs in military archives, visiting his friends, comrades and neighbors, learning about his early years, and family life. The author also had the cooperation and

help of Bayerleins nephew who shared intimate details of his uncles life including many family and behind the scenes war photos. Bayerleins personal friend, Manfred Rommel, provides remarkable insight into the mans nature. Over 340 photographs (many never before published and from his personal family collection), and twenty war maps drawn by Bayerlein, make this book a valuable addition to a military or biographical collection.

This scholarly anthology presents a new framework for understanding early cinema through its usage outside the realm of entertainment. From its earliest origins until the beginning of the twentieth century, cinema provided widespread access to remote parts of the globe and immediate reports on important events. Reaching beyond the nickelodeon theatres, cinema became part of numerous institutions, from churches and schools to department stores and charitable organizations.
