Las últimas imágenes realizadas ponen ya en evidencia las consecuencias de la crisis mundial que paralizó grandes programas cuyos edificios inacabados se encuentran abandonados bajo la única vigilancia de las grúas que los rodean. Los autores del libro han investigado los factores explicativos de tales mutaciones, adoptando un estricto modo geográfico basado en la realidad observada. El libro se ilustra con 112 fotografías, casi todas aéreas, interpretadas a través de croquis, con leyendas en español y en francés. Cada capítulo se complementa con un resumen en español o en francés, según la lengua del mismo, y en inglés.

The Green City and Social Injustice examines the recent urban environmental trajectory of 21 cities in Europe and North America over a 20-year period. It analyses the circumstances under which greening interventions can create a new set of inequalities for socially vulnerable residents while also failing to eliminate other environmental risks and impacts. Based on fieldwork in ten countries and on the analysis of core planning, policy and activist documents and data, the book offers a critical view of the growing green planning orthodoxy in the Global North. It highlights the entanglements of this tenet with neoliberal municipal policies including budget cuts for community initiatives, long-term green spaces and housing for the most fragile residents; and the focus on large-scale urban redevelopment and high-end real estate investment. Its breadth and diversity allow students, scholars and researchers to debunk the often-depoliticized branding and selling of green cities and reinsert core equity and justice issues into green city planning—a much-needed perspective. Building from this critical view, the book also shows how cities that prioritize equity in green access, in secure housing and in bold social policies can achieve both environmental and social gains for all.

Il s'agira de réfléchir aux formes que celles-ci peuvent prendre aujourd'hui à l'échelle du territoire français, en interrogeant notamment la marginalité des territoires ruraux, urbains ou péri-urbains. Il conviendra également de s'intéresser à la trajectoire des marges, voire à leur réversibilité, qui s'incarne dans des cycles de vie de durées variables. De manière tout aussi incontournable, cette question appelle à interroger les politiques publiques. La question de la France des marges est large et complexe, et appelle à mobiliser plusieurs champs et approches de la connaissance géographique : politique, sociale, économique, culturelle, rurale et urbaine ou encore des représentations.
